



# The Word Gap

"Parents who read 1 picture book with their children every day provide their children with exposure to an estimated 78,000 words each a year. Cumulatively, over the 5 years, we estimate that children from literacy-rich homes hear a cumulative 1.4 million more words during storybook reading than children who are never read to"

- Write confidently
- Speak articulately






### What can you do?

- 1. Practise the sounds and phrases
- Practise reading sounds speedily -
- 'review, review, review'
- 3. Use 'Special Friends', 'Fred Talk',
- read the word' to read words
- Practise 10 minutes reading a day
- Read one page, your child reads a page
- Share the library books we send home with SF stickers on.
- Practise our 'Favourite Five' at home



### Read, read, read





- ► STARTING WITH –
- Flashcards daily hopefully children will be able to tell you phoneme we have learnt if not it is in the handbook. We follow them most of the time in this order.
- Listen to them reading or in the early stages sharing their home reading books.
- Practise reading bookmarks which will be sent home
- Practise with magnetic letters making simple 3 letter words
- Practise writing the letters learnt at home
- ► Children thrive on repetition of favourite stories. The more a story belongs to a child the better


